Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) Staff Workshop

Peacemaker Resources will provide a 90-minute workshop on Social Emotional Learning -- what it is and why it is important. In this interactive workshop, teachers will learn about the Peacemaker program and have the opportunity to practice skills that they can use in their classroom.
