SEL 20 Lesson Model

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SEL 20 Lesson Model

Designed to provide support and ease for teachers, a Peacemaker Resources SEL Specialist joins teachers and students for 20 SEL lessons curated to support the need of the classroom as they go through the *SEL for Everyone* curriculum. This model builds the greatest connection between teachers, students and Peacemaker Resources SEL Specialists.

First 5 Lesson Model

This model is a jumpstart to using the Peacemaker Resources *SEL for Everyone* curriculum in the classroom. A Peacemaker Resources SEL Specialist joins a classroom for the first 5 lessons for SEL, then hands off the curriculum and materials kit to support classroom regulation, connection, and engagement. This is a good way to familiarize teachers with the rhythm and content of the *SEL for Everyone* curriculum and provide support throughout the teaching journey.

SEL for Everyone Curriculum Purchase

The Peacemaker Resources *SEL for Everyone* curriculum consists of 20 lessons, divided into four themed sets. It is designed to build social and emotional vocabulary and skills to support the classroom environment. We have designed our curriculum based on SEL research and best practices to support schoolwide efforts and implementation of SEL skills. In these lessons, students develop fundamental social and emotional competencies through sharing, listening, playing and regulation. These competencies include recognizing and managing emotions, developing care for others, establishing positive relationships, making responsible decisions, and handling challenging situations constructively. The lessons are developmentally appropriate and build in complexity from one grade level to the next.

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STAR Collaborative

STAR Collaborative is a SEL program that is composed of students from regional schools. STAR Collaborative meets 4-5 times a school year as a large group to build leadership in schools, and connection with other middle schoolers through experiential activities.

Districts can opt in to team teach SEL lessons to younger students with the support of Peacemaker Resources SEL Specialists.

**The STAR Collaborative programming is often supported by districts "Achievement and Integration" funding.*

STAR Multi-School

Gather with other regional schools for a two-day, overnight event where middle schoolers learn social and emotional skills through experiential activities. Throughout the event, Peacemaker Resources SEL Specialists provide guidance and positive role modeling for a team of students and an adult advisor from their school. Students practice leadership skills and practice presenting social emotional learning topics to peers and younger children. SEL Specialists then join teams back at their schools for a half-day of preparing and presenting to other classes. STAR Multi-School is a great way to meet youth from other communities and build confidence and leadership in young people!

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Peacemaker Expedition

Students and teachers embark on an adventure to work together, learn social and emotional skills and solve problems in these fun-filled, SEL adventures. Join us for a full-day, off-site field trip where we incorporate story-telling, cooperative games, and outdoor adventure for a wonder-filled day of learning and growth. During Peacemaker Expedition days, students spend time in circles to build community and participate in experiential SEL activities based on one of four themes. Guided by Peacemaker Resources SEL Specialists, students and teachers build connection and practice real world skills to bring back to the classroom.

Peacemaker 1/2 Day

Peacemaker Resources SEL Specialists guide students and teachers through experiential SEL activities including cooperative challenges, games, and lessons. Designed to build and support student leadership. Peacemaker 1/2 Days invite students to meet once per month, 5-8 times throughout the school year at their school. Topics and activities are customized to best support group needs in fun and engaging ways. Students are then invited to take on leadership roles within their school building such as teaching younger students, model SEL skills or leading school-wide initiatives.
